## DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

SMOKEHOUSE & HOOD CLEANER is ideally suited for automatic injection into in-place cleaning systems at 2-5 ounces per gallon of hot water. Alternatively, solutions can be prepared at 2-5 ounces per gallon and applied by mop or brush, then allowed to soak 3-5 minutes and pressure rinsed with water. In both cases it may be necessary to manually apply the cleaning solution to corners and duct-work where automatic spraying systems do not reach.
